PRIVACY STATEMENT

PERSONAL INFORMATION

That information is only used on this site and is not distributed or sold to any other party or site. Our software includes sophisticated encryption technology to ensure security and privacy when you access fund information, initiate online fund transactions, or send secure messages.

PUBLIC INFORMATION

Under the federal Internal Revenue Code, the following documents are public information:

- IRS Form 990 and related schedules for the past three years.
- Exemption letter from the IRS.
- Approved application for exemption with supporting documentation.

The Foundation's lists of donors (other than those published in the annual report, with permission) are not available to the public. We do not reveal the name of donors who wish to remain anonymous to the recipient of a grant.
